Reforms to motor industry laws

From 1 December 2014 the *Motor Dealers and Repairers Act 2013* replaced the *Motor Vehicle Repairs Act 1980*. Information about the changes is available on the following pages:

Motor vehicle repair businesses in NSW are currently regulated by the Motor Vehicle Repairs Act. The Act requires all motor vehicle repair businesses to be licensed and the tradespeople working in those businesses to be certified. These functions are performed by NSW Fair Trading as well as a dispute resolution service between motor vehicle owners and repairers.
